Master Showmanship

You must win Senior Showmanship in one Species(Beef Cattle, Goats, Sheep, or Swine) to be eligible and you must be a resident of Augusta County.

Friday, July 30 - 6:00 PM: Master Showmanship Competition begins

Round 1: Animal Agriculture Interview

Round 2: Beef Cattle Showmanship

Goat Showmanship

Sheep Showmanship

Swine Showmanship

Round 3: Audience Question(Impromptu Speaking)

Animals to be used for Round 2 will be selected by the barn committee and superintendents.

Animals will be assigned to the exhibitor by a random drawing (will not use the exhibitor's own animals).

Each round will be graded on a scale of 1 to 10 (Ex. - 8.5 allowable).

Livestock Committee will select one judge to evaluate this event.

All scores from the 3 rounds will be added together to determine the Master Showmanship Winner.

High score wins a \$1000 Scholarship.

*Winner of the Master Showmanship Contest will be ineligible to participate again in the Master Showmanship Contest but will be allowed to participate in any species Showmanship classes.
